8:45am-4:15pm

GROUP SIZE

Up to 9 participants. 2 person minimum. Reservations recommended. Contact Recreation Desk for availability and pricing for groups of 10 or more.

PRICE

\$195 adult; \$125 child (ages 4-15). Includes transportation, naturalist guide, and lunch voucher for use in our General Store. Additional \$20 park admission fee per adult (*waived for Yosemite Annual Pass or America the Beautiful Pass holders*).

DIFFICULTY/AGE LIMIT

Participants should be comfortable walking for about an hour at altitudes up to 7,200 ft.

MEETING PLACE

Meet 15 minutes before departure at the Rush Creek Lodge Recreation Desk (located in the Guest Lounge).

WHAT TO BRING

- Small backpack with a minimum of 2 liters of water per person and snacks
- Proper footwear – sturdy tennis shoes, trail runners, or hiking boots
- Layered clothing including wind/rain jacket or sweatshirt
- Bug repellent, sunscreen, hat and sunglasses
- Camera and binoculars (optional)

OTHER INFORMATION

Our first-aid-certified guides carry first aid kits, permits, maps, radios/cell phones. Guide gratuity not included; for exemplary service a 10-20% tip is customary.
