



YOSEMITE FIREFALL EXPRESS

February 8-9, 15-17, 22-23, 2025*



Firefall is a natural phenomenon that only occurs in Yosemite Valley in late February, as the setting sun illuminates El Capitan's seasonal Horsetail Fall, transforming the waterfall into a magical ribbon of cascading molten gold.

During the last three weekends of February's world-famous Firefall, the National Park Service implements a temporary reservation system for anyone driving their own vehicle into the Park.

Or you can avoid the reservation system, leave the driving and logistics to us, and enjoy a nice cup of hot cocoa along the way on our Yosemite Firefall Express Shuttle.



TRIP TIME

2pm-8pm

GROUP SIZE

Up to 7 participants. 2 person minimum. Reservations recommended. Contact Recreation Desk for availability and pricing for groups of 10 or more.

PRICE

\$120 per adult; \$90 per youth (Ages 8-15). Includes Yosemite day-use reservation, transportation. Additional \$20 park admission fee per adult (waived for Yosemite or America the Beautiful Annual Pass holders or families with a receipt for Park entry within 3-days).

DIFFICULTY/AGE LIMIT

Participants should be able to walk over a mile at a time on flat ground to view this event. Trip is suitable for ages 8 and up.

MEETING PLACE

Meet 15 minutes before departure at the Rush Creek Lodge Recreation Desk (located in the Guest Lounge).

WHAT TO BRING

- Completed trip registration forms
- Small backpack with at least 32 oz. water per person and snacks
- Proper footwear - ice and snow may be present
- Layered clothing including wind/rain jacket, gloves, and headwear
- Camera and binoculars (optional)

OTHER INFORMATION

Our first-aid-certified guides carry first aid kits, permits, maps, radios/cell phones and water filters. Guide gratuity is not included; for exemplary service, a 10-20% tip is customary.
