Wonders of Yosemite Hike & Tour

This 2-in-1 Yosemite Valley and Giant Sequoia guided naturalist tour is a memorable, fun way to get to know the park from an insider's perspective. Enjoy dramatic waterfalls, a spectrum of colorful landscapes and majestic Giant Sequoia trees.

9am - 5:30pm, Beginner-Intermediate Effort, \$195 per adult, \$125 per youth (ages 8-15)

Range of Light Yosemite Valley Tour

Following the footsteps of John Muir, we visit the Valley's most famous and impressive wonders as well as its hidden secrets, with plenty of time to stop, relax and enjoy on this Yosemite Valley Tour.

9am - 3pm, Beginner Effort, \$160 per adult, \$105 per youth (ages 4-15)

Giant Sequoia Hike or Snowshoe

This 3-mile round trip adventure explores the majesty of the Giant Sequoias. The stunning contrast of white snow against the red bark of the Sequoias, the largest living species on earth, is spectacular.

Rim of the Valley Snowshoe Adventure

Snowshoe to one of the finest overlooks in all of Yosemite: Dewey Point. Our adventure will take us up and down small forested ridges and through snow covered meadows to the breathtaking views of Yosemite Valley's south rim.

Valley Explorer Naturalist Hike

Come explore the hidden trails of Yosemite Valley! Our gentle to moderate 4 to 5-mile hike (or snowshoe) winds around many of Yosemite's iconic wonders and provides splendid views of seasonal creeks, meadows, and boulders with memorable views of Yosemite's iconic sights!
