Our small group tours are led by friendly, expert naturalist guides to help you make the most of your Yosemite vacation. Tours include transportation and lunch.

Wonders of Yosemite Hike & Tour

This 2-in-1 Yosemite Valley and Giant Sequoia guided naturalist tour is a memorable, fun way to get to know the park from an insider's perspective. Enjoy dramatic waterfalls, a spectrum of colorful landscapes, and majestic Giant Sequoia trees.

9am - 5:30pm, Beginner-Intermediate Effort, \$215 per adult, \$135 per youth (ages 8-15)

Range of Light Yosemite Valley Tour

Following the footsteps of John Muir, we visit the Valley's most famous and impressive wonders as well as its hidden secrets, with plenty of time to stop, relax and enjoy on this Yosemite Valley Tour.

9am - 3pm, Beginner Effort, \$180 per adult, \$120 per youth (ages 4-15)

Yosemite Valley & Glacier Point Tour

After soaking up Glacier Point's panoramic views, we'll meander through the Valley, possibly take a swimming break in the Merced River, or enjoy a shaded picnic in beautiful El Capitan Meadow while watching climbers ascend the world's largest granite rock face!

Yosemite High Country Naturalist Tour

Experience exquisite beauty as the Tuolumne River leaves its serene meadow setting and explodes into the Grand Canyon of the Tuolumne. Come face to face with massive glacial rocks left behind by 4,000 foot deep glaciers, and take a dip in the crystal clear waters of Tenaya Lake.

Big Trees Hike & Swim

This popular half day trip along the historic Big Oak Flat Road takes you into a grove of Yosemite's famous Giant Sequoias and ends up at one of our favorite local swimming holes for a swim and a picnic lunch!

9am-2:30pm, Beginner-Intermediate Effort, \$170 per adult, \$115 per youth (8-15 years)

Taft Point & Sentinel Dome Loop Hike

This 5.8-mile hike takes you between two stunning lookouts (Taft Point and Sentinel Dome) that gaze over the entirety of the valley throughout the majority of your hike.

Valley Explorer Naturalist Hike

Come explore the hidden trails of Yosemite Valley! Our gentle to moderate 4 to 5-mile hike (or snowshoe) winds around many of Yosemite's iconic wonders and provides splendid views of seasonal creeks, meadows, and boulders with memorable views of Yosemite's iconic sights!

Sunset Vista Happy Hour Tour

After a great day exploring the Park, or for those just checking in, there are few experiences more memorable and relaxing than to gaze upon the sun's final light as it slowly disappears into the Tuolumne River Canyon.
